Last Sunday Morning...

Elder Lorren Godwin preached. The title of his message was "Building a Memorial to God." We should always try to please God and not the world. We should love God with all of our hearts. In Acts chapter 10, God told Cornelius, "Thy prayers and thine alms are come up for a memorial before God." You can give to others to help them—give to a child at Christmas, serve at a homeless shelter, pray for the sick, etc. But we must always share the Gospel of Christ with people because it is the soul that is the most important. You can build a memorial by reaching out to the lost. David slew Goliath because the giant mocked God. Then the sword of Goliath was given to David for a memorial. God always gives us a memorial to remember the things He has done for us.

Last Sunday Night...

Elder David Harris preached. The title of his message was "Borrowed Faith." He drew from Bible passages in II Corinthians 4:8-9, Mark 2:1-5, and Acts 14:8-10. In Mark 2, four men carried a crippled man to Jesus to be healed. The crippled man had to borrow faith to get there. When you are down with problems, you have to borrow faith. Tell someone when you need uplifted in spirit. Go to church and ask for help. We all have a measure of faith. All we need is faith as a grain of mustard seed.

Pastor Joseph preached. His key verse was II Chronicles 7:14 "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land." A summary of this is God saying, "All right, I'm listening. What are you going to say to me in prayer?" He then read Acts 3:1 "Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer." He titled his message "Praying On Purpose." We all need an hour of prayer, an hour set aside each day to worship and talk to God. Be consistent in prayer. Maintain prayer as part of the altar in your life. Set the right example.
