Last Sunday Morning...

Elder Lorren Godwin taught from I Samuel 5:1-5. The Philistines took the Ark of the Covenant from Israel and set it in the temple of their god, Dagon (god of fertility). Their idol, Dagon, was shaped like a man's head and hands with a body and tail like a fish. The next morning when they came into their temple, Dagon was fallen onto his face before the Ark of God. They set him back up, but the next morning, their idol had fallen again; and that time his hands and his head had broken off. Satan fights us, but he cannot withstand us when we allow God's power to manifest in our lives. Each temptation, battle, and problem can be defeated if we allow God to work through us. And He can work through us even when we are weak: A prophet named Elisha once requested and got a double portion of anointing from God. Years later, after he was dead and buried. Israel was in a war. Some Jews were carrying a dead comrade, when an enemy group appeared. They threw the soldier's corpse into the tomb of Elisha. The Bible says that the man stood up and walked out of the tomb when his body touched the bones of Elisha. Even if you think you are weak and powerless, God can still use you! Allow His presence to flood through your life and watch the enemy bow before God!

Last Sunday Night...

Associate Pastor David Harris Jr. preached on "Apostolic Power." He took his text from Luke 10:17-20. Jesus told His disciples "I give unto you power" (Luke 10:19). Also He told them "But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you" (Acts 1:8). The Holy Ghost bestows power to us. This power is spiritual strength, not physical strength. When we receive the Holy Ghost we receive this power. We must pray and let Jesus lead us. When Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness (Mark 4), He fasted and prayed for forty days. "And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about" (Mark 4:14). If we would fast and pray more, we would have more power. The Holy Ghost can grant power that others can feel as we pass by them. (At the conclusion of the sermon, praises were sung and many souls, including the young people, were mightily blessed by God.)

Last Wednesday Night...

Pastor Joseph preached "Be The Man!" using Numbers 2:9 for his text. Judah, the strongest tribe, was given the #1 spot in the camp, and was to be the first tribe to go out to battle. To be of the Tribe of Judah was to be a leader. Pastor Joseph encouraged the men of CAC to be godly leaders in their families, leading in all things spiritual, not just in economics, careers, or sports. The name Judah is rendered in the Old Testament as Judah and Jehudah, and in the New Testament as Jude and Judas. The name actually means *celebrated*. Also, the name is derived from a root word (vadah) that has several good meanings and one bad meaning. Its better meanings include "to use the hand", "to throw (a stone or arrow) at or away", and especially "to revere or worship (with extended hands)", as well as "cast (out), confess (or make confession), praise, shoot, thank (or give thanks), thankful, thanksgiving." Its not-so-good meaning is "to bemoan (by wringing the hands)" Judas Iscariot was a wicked man in the New Testament who bore this same name. When Mary broke an alabaster box of ointment in her worship to the Lord Jesus, the bemoaning Judas could only wring his hands and worry about the waste of money. How sad. He lived out the worst meaning instead of the best.


