

Sunday, February 11, 2007...

Pastor Joseph completed a multi-part lesson entitled "The Trial of Faith." It was the 38th lesson in our ongoing series called "Teaching the Apostolic Faith." Also, it was the last of 17 lessons within that series that formed a section on "Holiness and Christian Living" topics. (We have now completed two entire sections; the first contained topics on "Bible and Doctrine"). Since the second section has now been completed, we are about to embark on a new, third section of "Leadership and Ministry" topics. Previously, we had discussed five out of seven causes of trials. Last week we examined the remaining two causes—which were: (6) We sacrifice for the will of God (I John 3:16); and (7) God tests and purifies us (I Peter 1:6-9; John 15:2; James 1:2-4; II Corinthians 12:7-10)—and then we discussed how to overcome trials. We must first identify the causes of our trials, learn from them, and then respond accordingly. We must resist the devil and draw close to God. We must live by faith and patience. God will give us grace to endure and escape (I Corinthians 10:13). Our attitude will make the difference between defeat and victory.

A missionary service was scheduled with Joel Richardson (missionary to Gabon, Africa), but a winter storm made the roads dangerous for the missionary (who was in Ohio visiting with family). We called the missionary and he agreed with us to postpone his date to be with us. The future date is yet to be set. A small number of CAC members did arrive for church that night. 
