

<p>Last Sunday we celebrated the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Pastor Joseph preached a message about the Lord, entitled “Let’s Roll.” As the time of His crucifixion and resurrection drew near, Jesus tried to forewarn his disciples. Then, He had them stand and begin the journey toward His own death by saying, “Arise, let us go hence.” These words were very similar to the famous phrase “Let’s roll” spoken by Todd Beamer, a normal citizen turned hero, who joined with other passengers and resisted the terrorists controlling Flight 93 on September 11, 2001. Todd Beamer went to face possible death with an upbeat attitude, knowing that victory could still end in death, but yet would save lives. Jesus faced not only the possibility of death, but the surety of death. And, unlike Todd Beamer, who boarded the plane having no idea what lay ahead, Jesus knew exactly what pain and death lay between Him and His resurrection, yet He chose to endure the suffering, despising the shame, because of the joy that was set before Him. Because He lives, we can have eternal life!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached from the Numbers 26, a message entitled “Pass the Torch, Fan the Flames.” God told Moses and Eleazar to take a second census of God’s people. The comparison of the first census and the second revealed that all who had doubted God had died in the wilderness. Out of hundreds of thousands of people, Joshua and Caleb were the only two men who believed God and survived to enter the promised land. All the others who entered the promised land were descendents of those who doubted and died. God is concerned about church growth, but He cares more about how strong our marriages are, and about how many of our children grow up and stay in the church. We need to pass the torch of truth to the next generation, and fan the flames so that our children won’t backslide, if the Lord should delay His return. As godly parents, we need to keep our marriages strong and teach our children the truth. Let’s do more to win our kids and keep them here in church after they grow up and marry. Short-term evangelism will benefit us little if we lose our kids and our marriages, but if we have strong marriages and raise strong kids, the church will explode with growth. We must teach our children God’s ways!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught a lesson entitled “Toward Stronger Marriages.” He asked two couples to testify about certain aspects of strength in their marriages. Brother David and Sister Diane Todd have been married for about 27 years. They testified about the strength of being best friends in a marriage. Sister Joseph’s parents, Brother Larry and Sister Donyia Mullins, were in town visiting during the Resurrection holiday. They have been married for over 40 years. They testified about the strength of good communication in marriage. Several areas of weakness in husbands and wives were mentioned, and good tips were given to aid in getting victory over those weaknesses. The devil would love to attack and ruin our marriages, but God is helping us to beat the odds and succeed.</p>
