<p>A Gideon Representative, Randy Foxx, gave a good presentation. Pastor Joseph taught “To Please Daddy” using I Corinthians 15:45 as his text. Children have a healthy desire to please their earthly daddies. Sometimes as humans, natural dads let their children down, yet often the children still love them. When a man looks at his own child, he often sees a reflection of himself. He may like what he sees, or not. This may cause a man to be unjust with his children. But no such injustices or imperfections are found in our Heavenly Father. Unlike human dads, God knows our hearts accurately. He also knows all the future, and He has perfect wisdom for perfect choices. We ought to focus on pleasing our Heavenly Father more than our natural father. And we ought to concentrate more on character of the heart, and less on carnal qualities like IQ, appearance, or height. But though the Bible tells <i>children</i> to <i>obey</i> their parents, it instructs <i>adults</i> to <i>honor</i> their parents instead. So, an adult need not always obey his or her parents.
