<p>Pastor Joseph taught “Honoring Our Heritage” using Exodus 20:12, Psalm 27:10 and Mark 10:29-30. On Judgment Day, men will be judged according to their deeds. We are responsible for our actions. God cares about how we relate to others. Six of the Ten Commandments tell us how to relate to others. In the first of these six, God commanded us to honor our father and mother that our days may be long on the earth. Sometimes our feelings (or our “heart” thoughts) get in the way of God’s commandment. Truth isn’t based on feelings. Your feelings will make you do wrong. One’s own heart is deceitful. No matter how ungodly/wrong your mother is/was, avoid dishonoring her. Sometimes we may need to let a thing go, and all confronting of problems should be done respectfully. When we have a conflict with our parents, we can still honor them by handling the conflict respectfully. Obeying and honoring are not the same. Children are to <i>obey</i> their parents. Adults are to <i>honor</i> their parents. The promise of longer life for honoring one’s parents is a general statement. However other things we do to ourselves could make our life shorter. If one has ungodly parents, he should remember that God’s Word comes first. We can still honor and respect them by showing them love and kindness. Be a godly witness before them. For orphans or those with ungodly parents, God can provide spiritual role models to help.</p>	<p>Elder Lorren Godwin ministered the Word of God. We have come to a fork in the road. Choose the one that Jesus is on, no matter the cost. Some today are not in love with the Word of God. We need to witness and not worry about what they will think of us. Live for God 100%. If we always do what we’ve always done, we’ll always get what we’ve always gotten. Come to church and truly worship Jesus with your whole heart. People think that just because we are having a special service that they will get a touch from God. But Jesus is in every service. We just have to yield to His Spirit. In Luke 19, dishonest Zacchaeus repented, desiring to please the Lord. Jesus told him, “Today is salvation come to your house.” The woman at the well was a downtrodden outcast. Jesus told her that if she would drink of the water that He could give, she would never thirst again. She told all the people, “Come see a man who...” She had been with Jesus only 15 minutes, yet she was changed. The woman with an issue of blood pressed through a crowd to touch Jesus. She was healed by faith. We must draw a line, and determine to touch Jesus.</p>	<p>Elder David Harris preached using Hebrews 12:26-27 as his text. God is going to not only shake the earth again, but Heaven too: “Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven” (Hebrews 12:27). When God speaks, something is going to happen. There’s more to serving God than just dancing and rejoicing. We need to find a corner and seek God’s face. In Acts 28, Paul shook off into the fire a venomous viper that had fastened on his hand. God protects His people and keeps His hand upon them. We need to shake some things loose. We need to tell our kids there is a God who loves them and cares for them. Stir up the Holy Ghost within you. The Holy Ghost is real. Some spirits may trouble us, but God is about to shake some things loose. Once we have seen signs, wonders and miracles we ought not sink back into the same rut we were in before. Why do we do that sometimes? We need to shake ourselves and be free from problems of the past.</p>
