


Pentecost Sunday (also was a Memorial Sunday)	Last Wednesday
<p>Our Veterans (both present & past) were honored in the service.</p> <p>Rev. Perry Harris, former Assoc. Pastor at CAC, now living in North Carolina, was our guest minister. He preached “Power of Pentecost.” Let not your heart be troubled. Jesus did go away to prepare a place for us. Heaven, a city whose builder and maker is God, is a wonderful place. John the Baptist foretold the coming of Jesus: “I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire” (Matthew 3:11). And on the day of Pentecost, the Holy Ghost came “as of a rushing mighty wind...and there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them, and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance” (Acts 2:2-4). There were devout men from every nation in Jerusalem on the day of Pentecost. They were amazed to hear these men speak in their language. This was a miracle of God. Peter stood up in the midst of them and said, “This is that”! Jesus Christ is the power of Pentecost. We need to give Him All we have when we worship Him. We need to put some physical exercise into our worship. We need to serve God with our whole heart. He is a “rewarder of them that diligently seek him” (Hebrews 11:6). Desire God; seek Him. In the early church, God added souls to the church daily. In Acts chapters 3 and 4, Peter and John healed the lame man who sat daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful. They preached Jesus unto the people. This angered the rulers of the city. Peter and John were arrested and the rulers asked them, “By what power, or by what name, have ye done this?” (Acts 4:7). They answered that the name of Jesus was the power (Acts 4:12). Peter and John spoke with boldness, adding “Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.” Jesus is the only way. We are witnesses for Jesus. Act like you did when you first received the Holy Ghost. Stir up the gift that is within you. Let’s go out and boldly proclaim Jesus to the world.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught “The 1:4 Garden of God” using Mark 4:8 as his text. You have to choose every day how you are going to live. We need to treat each day as if it’s precious. We can either ruin our day or make it special. You need to have a good attitude and say I’m going to take whatever life has dealt and make the best of it. God made us creatures of free will. We can choose to be on the inside or outside. The sower went out to sow the seed. Some fell on stony ground, some fell by the wayside, some fell on thorny ground and some fell on good ground. The seed is the Word of God which is alive, powerful and pure. We can’t blame the preacher; all he does is sow God’s Word. It is our choice if we apply it to our life. The devil tries to get the Word that was sowed. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Let the Word of God take root in you deeply. Allow the Lord to pluck out of your heart any “stones” and “thorns”, and resist the “birds” (devils) so that you can be good ground with good fruit coming forth.</p>


