

<p>Elder David Harris preached “What Does Your Faith Say?” using Hebrews 11: 1-6. “Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen” (Hebrews 11:1). Have faith in God. We need to have faith in what God tells us. When God tells us He’s going to do something, have faith; it will be done. It’s easier to believe when someone here tells us something, because we can see them. With God we must just have faith. God will tell us good things; nothing false and nothing just to embarrass us. The world doesn’t believe what we tell them. Many people are afraid of Apostolic churches, but have faith in God. Our faith sometimes wavers in circumstances where things go wrong. We just need to trust God. We need to make sure our act is together with God, or we’re going to miss out on things. God’s Spirit is all that keeps the devil from overpowering the saints of God. The Holy Ghost keeps the devil afraid. We need to quit worrying about what others think and say because we’re not in bondage. God loves us all. The Holy Ghost, God’s Spirit, is real. What does your faith say to you each day? Everyone walks in faith differently.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “Sell Out To The Lord” using Judges 1: 27-36, 2: 1-5. God has commanded His people to be ye perfect. Man cannot perfect himself; God breathes upon us perfection. When man looks back upon sins he has committed and sees how he has hurt people (his parents, family, etc), it gives him strength to live a more devoted life for God. God is perfecting you. He will cause perfection to burst through in you. You need to lay yourself on God’s altar and let Him burn out all your imperfections. We need to say “O God, make me.” In chapters 1 and 2 of Judges, God recounted to His people their rebellious sins of disobedience. He told them what He had done for them, then asked them “but ye have not obeyed my voice: why have ye done this?” (Judges 2: 2) God loves us, but sometimes He has to get stern with us. Our pastor loves us, and he also has to get stern with us sometimes. We need to lay our ALL on the altar, including weaknesses big and small, all sins and every problem, and let God burn out any imperfections we may have. God will breathe perfection upon us. We must keep God’s commandments. “But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected.” (I John 2:5)</p>



