

Elder Lorren Godwin preached with Ezekiel 37:1- 4 as his text. God expects us to say, "Yes, these dead bones can live." When bad things happen, some talk to others and not to God, complaining and blaming God for circumstances they created. We ought to serve God because we love Him. We need to be careful of the words that we speak because the devil is listening and trying to cut in. He plans his attack by what we say. Sometimes we're spiritually down and don't worship God. But if we will worship He will help us. A fountain can't bring forth bitter and sweet water at the same time. Our words and attitude determine if we fall or rise up. The big things are not what will destroy us. It's the small things like our words and actions that destroy us. As humans we're susceptible to believe the worst. We must overcome that impulse. We should come into church ready to worship.	Elder David Harris preached "Let's Protect The Anointing" using Isaiah 10:27, I John 2: 20, 27 and II Timothy 1:6. When we receive the Holy Ghost, we receive the anointing of God. We need to cherish this. Keep it precious! He should mean more to us than any material things we have. We need to "stir up the gift of God"— the anointing that is within us. We can lay hands on each other in prayer (and even upon ourselves) because we have the anointing within us. The Holy Ghost is not to be played around with. If we don't stay prayed- up and close to God, the Lord's presence in us will diminish. "Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you" (John 15:16). We need to protect this anointing.	Bro. Rusty Sandy preached "Leave Your Remote at Home" using Matthew 14:29-31 as his text. Peter obeyed Jesus when He bid him "come." But when he saw the wind contrary, he feared and doubted. We are like Peter sometimes. We fear and doubt. People will come for prayer, and then doubt comes. They get the remote and fast forward to see what is going to happen. Some put their remote on pause or stop and just sit still while church is going on. Some come to church and focus on how their flesh is feeling. Let's have <u>church</u> . We need to be like Peter. Even when he was beginning to sink, he cried out, "Lord, save me!" If you need something from God, go to the altar for prayer. Let the Word of God speak to you.
