<p>Elder David Harris preached “Simply Jesus” using John 1: 1-9 as his main text. In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The Word is the Logos (thought, plan, or intent) of God. Verse 14 of the same chapter says “the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us.” God’s <i>plan</i> became a <i>man</i>. The Word (God’s plan) was made flesh as the man Jesus Christ. He was and is God revealed or expressed as a human being. Psalm 119:11 says, “Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.” If we have the Word hidden in our heart, we have Jesus hidden in our heart. Getting Jesus within us is the greatest event that can happen to anyone. We live in a ‘show me’ generation. People don’t want you to tell them what Jesus can do. They say “show me’ what He can do. When Paul saw the crippled man at Lystra he knew that Jesus could heal him. Paul told him to stand upright on his feet, and the man leaped up and walked. We must know that Jesus heals, that He provides, that He lives within us so we can be a witness for Him. God has given us power to witness. Sometimes we move so fast that we forget about Jesus. All that it takes is simply Jesus.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “It’s All In The Timing” using I Kings 18:36, Psalm 119:162 and Luke 5:5-6. Peter and his helpers had been fishing all night and caught nothing. Then Jesus told them to cast their nets out just one more time. Simon answered, “Master, we have toiled all night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless <u>at thy word</u> I will let down the net.” They caught so many fish, their nets broke. When the timing is right, it’s going to happen. We may come to service after service and pray faithfully, while seemingly nothing happens. But never give up. It will happen when we, simply because of God’s Word, try it just one more time. We need to keep asking, calling, witnessing, knocking on doors, driving the bus. Do it just one more time. What we’re doing is right. The Master told us to do it. When the time is right, the miracle is going to happen.</p>	<p>There was a powerful move of God in this service. Bro Baron Claypool was in attendance, and he was mightily touched by the Lord. Intercession was made for several people with needs, and the Lord touched many. The Lord brought forth a powerful message from Associate Pastor David Harris. His title was “Shut the Mouth of the Lion.” His scripture texts were 1Peter 5:8 and Hebrews 11:33. The Bible tells that through faith certain heroes: subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, and <u>stopped the mouths of lions</u>. In our day, we are often spiritually attacked by the devil, as a roaring lion. But like the saints of old, we have on our side the Lion of the Tribe of Judah—Jesus Christ! He helps us to shut the jaws of Satan and be victorious.</p>

In I Corinthians 7:8 we read that he himself was single! Did you know he was single for at least part of his ministry? In 2000, 56% of adults were married. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 20.2 million adults are divorced. • 13.5 million adults are widowed. • 36 % of all family types are single parent families. • Unmarried couple households increased 71 % from 1990 to 2000 and by a whopping 864% from 1960 to 2000 (from 439,000 couples in 1960 to 5.5 million couples in 2000). |
