Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Letting Go" using II Kings 13:14 and II Corinthians 10:3-6. As humans, we are often pack rats. We love to collect stuff, and then we have trouble of letting it go. The Lord is the giver of rest. Yet we carry stuff around and hold onto things that weight us down. Enemy strongholds within our minds can keep us from obtaining blessings from God. Many elements of our thought lives can become idols. These can include any unhealthy obsession, including over our job, home, money, etc. If we let anything come before God, it then becomes an idol. When we pray, often distractions come to mind. All we need to do is let go and please God. If we focus our mind on God we can win the battle. Satan knows which buttons to push to bring up our past and weigh us down. God tells us to lay aside every weight. The lust of the eye, the lust of the flesh and the pride of life will destroy us. We may be unaware of the weights because we can be so accustomed to them. Many times we cruise along just "great" until we hit a bump in the road, such as our marriage falling apart, financial problems, things go wrong, etc. Then these weights hold us down. When we go through life with all our weights shifting from side to side, it will destroy us. If we let go, the Lord will help us, and

even fight our battles for us.

Pastor Joseph preached from Proverbs 10:22: "The blessing of the LORD, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it." Those who seek after worldly wealth instead of seeking after the blessing of God, just may get the wealth they seek, but they will suffer the sorrows that come with it. But the blessing of the Lord makes one wealthy in a way that does not add sorrow. The most wonderful thing to pursue after is a close relationship with God. This should be our main pursuit in life. Esau was the eldest of twin sons by mere minutes. Being the eldest meant Esau was entitled to a double portion of his father's wealth and was to have authority over his "younger" brother, Jacob. Yet Esau had no desire for his father's blessing or the spiritual aspects of his birthright (i.e. line of Christ). Jacob had a desperate desire for it. Even though Jacob did wrong to get the blessing, God took Esau's blessing and gave it to Jacob. God does not bless a man for his righteousness. He blesses the man for his pursuit of God's blessings. Let's pursue after God's blessings with all we are.
