<p>Elder Lorren Godwin taught on the reaction of the three groups that received the news of Jesus' birth. The wise men followed the star, bringing gifts fit for a king. They sought advice from the king. The king, upon hearing the news of a newborn king, was angry and desired to destroy the baby. He rejected outright the notion of sharing his throne with anyone. The wise men sought until they found the king. The shepherds who were watching their sheep, abandoned their flocks upon hearing the message of the angels, and ran to find this newborn King. When they found him, they ran and proclaimed the news all around Bethlehem. When we hear the message of Jesus, we have three responses: rejection, investigation and acceptance. The shepherds' lives were changed. They were keepers of the sacrificial lambs, which were no longer needed, because the Lamb of God was born—the perfect Lamb that would take away the sin of the world.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "The Wonderful Name of Jesus" using Isaiah 9:6-7 as his main text. The Bible says of Jesus that He is to be called "Wonderful Counselor," the "Mighty God," the "Everlasting Father," and the "Prince of Peace." He is also to be called "Emmanuel" which being interpreted is "God with us" (Matthew 1:21). The ultimate meaning of Jesus name is "God-Saviour" or "God is Salvation." There is no other name like Jesus. God has highly exalted His name above all other names (Phil 2:9). Jesus is the only saving name; the only name whereby we must be saved (Acts 4:12). All of God's attributes, character, authority, and power are revealed in the person of Jesus and all of these are invoked by calling on the name of Jesus, who is the exact image of God. Like Thomas did, we call Jesus our "Lord" and our "God." Everything we need we find in the name of Jesus, whether it be a healing, deliverance, miracle, or forgiveness. It's ALL in the name of Jesus.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached on stability, using the title "Give Your All." He read from Isaiah 33:5-6 and Matthew 22:37-38. For the wicked, God's judgment is to be feared, but the righteous look forward to it without fear. Wisdom is all about making right choices. When we make decisions toward righteousness we are using good judgment, because of remembering that God's judgment will eventually come. Unwise choices are those that pretend that no judgment is coming. Jesus is only one who has a perfect track record of always choosing wisely. We ought to strive to be like Him in that. His Spirit in our lives helps us to make right choices. We ought to be stable even during tough times. Peace should rule and reign in our lives. Bad choices lead to unstable lives. Some people are rebellious and don't care. We are to love God with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength. Then we will not have mixed allegiance, which makes one unstable (James 1:8). Build your life on the solid rock, Jesus Christ.</p>

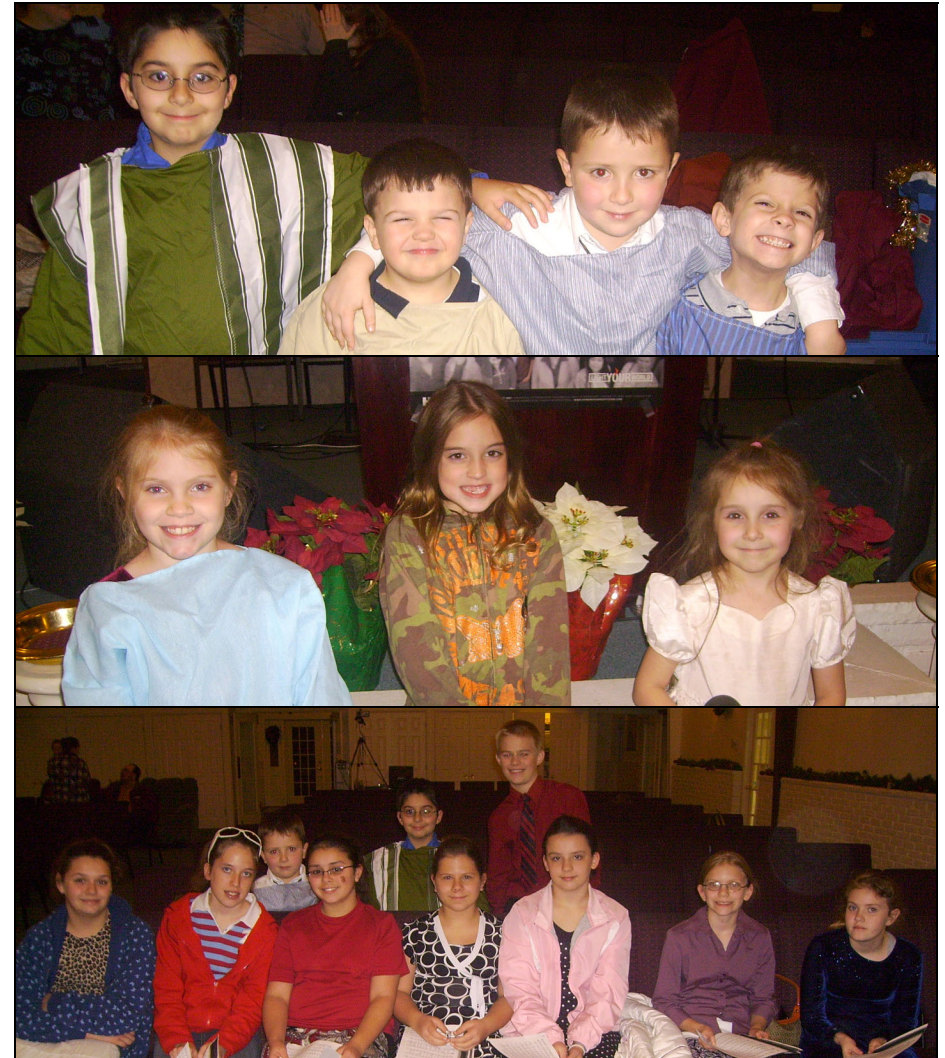
