Elder Harris preached and exhorted briefly under a powerful anointing of the Spirit. Elder Harris was blessed with great faith, and the Lord worked wonders. A family of guests in attendance that night was greatly moved, and they prayed and were touched by God. The husband was laid out under the power of God. The wife sought God was touched. Their adult son received the baptism of the Spirit! The dad is currently investigating the contrast between the baptismal formula invented by the Catholics (using three titles instead of Jesus name) and BIBLICAL baptism <u>in Jesus name!</u> Let’s hold this family up in prayer that God’s Word will be opened to them so that they will see that obeying Acts 2:38 (and Acts 8:16, 10:48, 19:5, and 22:16) does not contradict Matthew 28:19 at all, but rather fulfills its command.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught and preached a message entitled “On Guard” drawing on wording from 1 Cor. 4:1-17. The Apostle Paul, under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, described himself and other ministers of Christ in service with him as “stewards” of the mysteries of God (4:1). The original word for steward (<i>oikonomos</i> in Greek) literally means “custodian” or “one who is the law of the house.” “Mysteries” refer to those truths of God which cannot be discovered by man but must be revealed by God (see Eph. 3:3). As ministers we are the custodians of God’s revealed truths. <u>So be on guard.</u> Don’t be like the Corinthians, who had a tendency to drift into doubtful doctrines and to waste their time in strife and division. There are many voices in the world, and even from beyond this realm (voices of demons). Don’t believe them! Trust in the Word of God. His Word is true!</p>
