

She was among those possibly to be chosen. She trusted the eunuch servant, Hegai, to give her what she needed to please the king. Likewise, we should trust our servant, the pastor, to help us in pleasing the King of kings. There’s more to the Kingdom of God than just “heaven-or-hell” issues. Our goal is higher: to please our King! Esther’s cousin, Mordecai, was her guide and counsel. Eventually Haman, a wicked man, sought to kill all of the Jews. Mordecai sent word to Esther to entreat the king on behalf of the Jews. She knew that if entered the throne room uninvited, the penalty was death, unless the king raised the golden scepter. She risked death, saying, “If I die, I die.” Just as Haman once tried to destroy the Jews, today an evil seeks to destroy us. We need to enter God’s throne room! Because of the blood of Jesus, we can enter into the presence of God. 
