<p>Rev. Pascal Crites, visiting minister from Keyser, WV, preached “What is the Value of Your Vineyard?” using I Kings 21:1-4. King Ahab coveted the vineyard of his neighbor, Naboth. But the land was Naboth’s family inheritance, and Naboth invoked Mosaic Law in refusing to sell it. At first Ahab baited Naboth, promising he would give him a better vineyard in exchange for his land, once sold. But Naboth was not fooled. Don’t let the devil lie to you. He’s after your vineyard. Don’t trade your walk with God for the devil’s cheap tricks. Be in love with the Word of God and your vineyard. Finally, Ahab and his wicked wife Jezebel had Naboth murdered in order to take his property, but God rose up and judged them for it. Down through the ages, Naboth is honored as a man of principle. Today, the devil sees our vineyard: our spiritual inheritance of baptism in Jesus name & receiving the Holy Ghost with speaking in tongues. Some so-called religious people don’t want truth. But we don’t need a “feel good religion.” Sin is still sin, and it will send souls to hell. We need the truth, and preachers must preach truth to save sinners. The foolishness of preaching will save them that believe. <i>How valuable is your vineyard?</i> Be excited about your salvation! The devil wants us to sell out. Don’t be enticed out of your vineyard.</p>	<p>Bro Parry Harris Sr, a visiting minister from Salisbury, NC, preached “Onward Christian Apostolic Church.” He exhorted the church to press forward. We must finish this race! We must learn to trust one another. Have faith in God. We need to go to God and be desperate: <i>What do I need to do to survive?</i> God is our help. Elder Harris told many amazing testimonies of the miraculous power of God providing for the needs of the saints, oftentimes by leading some of the saints to uphold their brothers and sisters and help meet their needs. We must be in that survival mode!</p>
