It is the Lord who gives us salvation; who establishes us to walk in His ways. We are saved by grace through faith. Faith is a gift, not something conjured up of our own power. The devil is not so concerned with stopping you from doing good works. He is more focused on us letting go of our faith. He will do everything he can to attack our faith. He attacks our faith in the Word of God. He will tell you that you can live anyway you want because there is no accountability.
