

Fear can be a valid, healthy response to legitimate dangers or challenges. But fear can also be a spirit; an attack against us by nothing more than a spirit. And that spirit—that attack—does not come from God. The Bible says, “For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind” (II Timothy 1:7). That kind of fear seeks to be an unwelcome intruder in our lives. We must resist it. We must fight against it. Our two greatest allies in the battle against the enemy of unwanted, unhealthy fear, are God’s perfect love and God’s power. I John 4:18-19 says, “There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love. We love him, because he first loved us.” We can see God’s love (the staff) and His power (the rod) in Psalm 23:4: “...I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.” Live free from fear!</p>
