<p>Pastor Joseph &amp; Elder John Sandy taught “Free Indeed” using John 8:36. We should be thankful to be Americans. We have freedom of worship. We should pray for our country’s leaders. The Lord said, “If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land” (II Chronicles 7:14). Elder John Sandy’s topic was the freedom to be healthy. An important part of being healthy is eating right. Unfortunately, foods that have really good taste are often unhealthy for us. However, even more important than eating right, is that God wants us to live a peaceful life. The Bible says, “Follow peace with all men...” (Hebrews 12:14). Following peace is healthy. It is healthy for us to let go of the unnecessary stresses that are caused by interpersonal conflicts. Too much stress can cause all kind of medical problems. Don’t spend your life frustrated because of trying to control others. That is unhealthy. We cannot control others! However, we can control ourselves. We can and should control what stays in our mind. The longer we hold onto any unresolved bitterness or hard feelings, the harder it is to get rid of. Another part of being truly healthy is to remove the stress of always being in a hurry. Let us not be in a hurry. What kind of effect are we having on ourselves and others? Pastor Joseph spoke on the freedom to be wealthy. Dr. James Dobson has said, “The body, soul, and spirit are close neighbors; if one is ill, the others are soon affected.” One cannot be spiritually high if he or she is physically sick or emotionally low. Some people teach or think that being wealthy is evil, but that is not true. Many godly men in the Bible were wealthy. The love of money is the root of all evil, but it is not a sin to be wealthy. If we trust in the Lord, we should not suffer lack: “The Lord is my Shepherd, I shall not want” (Psalms 23:1). We can have freedom from want. “My God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus” (Phil. 4:19). God will help us, especially if we are careful stewards with our money. Use money wisely. Save for the future. Those who are younger should carefully invest in the stock market <b>early in life</b>, which will yield a large nest egg for retirement. Thank God for freedom of worship and speech, freedom from want and fear, and for salvation—freedom from sin!</p>	<p>Elder Lorren Godwin preached from Ps. 119:11: “Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.” Dad always kept a recent copy of the atlas/road map, so he could get his family wherever we needed to go.
