The scripture tells us to love our neighbors as we love ourselves. So, a normal amount of love for self is allowed. But don't think too much of yourself. What I think I am is not always the same as what I really am. The body, soul, and spirit are like close neighbors. Whatever happens to one will usually affect the others. When we are spiritually sick our body and soul are affected. Likewise, when our body is sick our spirit and soul are affected. Don't be arrogant. Don't refuse to fellowship with the poor or less intelligent. Be willing to associate to people of low position. Every member of the Body has a job. One is not free of the others. There is room in the Lord's body for all kinds.</p>
