**Sunday PM** Pastor Joseph preached "Great is Thy Faithfulness" using Lamentations 3:17-26. It was because of the Lord's compassion that the backslidden and wicked sons of Jacob were not all consumed (Malachi 3:6). When the nation of Israel was destroyed, God showed compassion on some Jews, because He had made certain promises that had to be fulfilled through the Jews. For instance.
