**Last Sunday AM** Associate Pastor David Harris preached "He Hath Done Great Things" using Psalms 126:3. If we stay faithful to Him. God will do great things for us. His mercy endureth forever. He knows everything; He is a great, big God. The revelation of the Bible is coming to pass. We need to look at the great things of God; the precious help of the Holy Ghost. We cannot focus on the depression in our world today. Don't focus on the negative. Think on the great works of God. God is in control no matter what may come our way. He is our provider. We need to give thanks to the God of Heaven. We need to lay troubles aside, think on heavenly things and praise the Lord. American culture claims that if we have the best house and best car that we are blessed. But the truth is if we have the essentials in life and are a child of God, we are truly BLESSED. If God hadn't saved us we could have been drug addicted or murderers. We need to be thankful every day for the great things God has done for us.

**Sunday PM** Pastor Joseph preached "It's In The Becoming" using John 1:1-14. Before God created the world. He knew all that would happen. In the beginning was God's plan (*Logos*: His Word). The ultimate goal of God's plan was when the Word became flesh; when the Plan became a man. Those who should have recognized Him, missed Him entirely. Wednesday PM Pastor Joseph preached "Wise Men Still Seek Him" using Matthew 2:1-2. The magi (or wise men) were Medo-Persian scholars. Their ancestors were exposed to prophetic truth about the Messiah during the time of Daniel. Thus, they were watching for the sign! When they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceeding great joy. Faith was confirmed to them. The star was a unique sign – it did not track along in motion like the other stars. Just as their ancestors passed truth along, we need to pass this truth to our kids. God picked Abraham because

He knew he would teach Gods truths to his sons. And if you did not have anyone to teach you the truth, there is still hope. God always rewards those who are hungry for Him! "Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled" (Matt.5:6). When the wizards (magi) came into the house to see the young child Jesus, they presented unto Him gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. But the gift God wants the most, is for

us to give Him all of
