<p>Elder Charles Hoskins preached “How? How? Holy Ghost, That’s How!” using Luke 1:5-25. There is hope. God can do what we can not. Zacharias and his wife Elisabeth were both stricken in years but an angel came and told them they would have a child. <i>How? The Holy Ghost!</i> There had been no physical relationship between Mary and Joseph, yet she was going to have a baby. <i>How? The Holy Ghost!</i> We can’t stop the storm; we can’t heal the sick, but the Holy Ghost can. We can overcome the enemy. <i>How? The Holy Ghost!</i> We must follow Jesus. He is the Door; He is the Light. It’s a journey, walking with Jesus. When problems arise, He will make a way for you. <i>How? The Holy Ghost!</i> We must worship Him in spirit and in truth. Jesus is our shelter. We need to dwell in the secret place of the most High – under the shadow of the Almighty. He’s our refuge and fortress; our safety and security. He can protect us from the devil’s trap. We need to be saturated in the Holy Ghost.</p>	<p>The Spirit of the Lord moved in an awesome way as souls, both young and old, sought the Lord. Pastor Joseph read James 5:14-18. Note that verse 15 says “the prayer of faith shall <u>save</u> the sick.” Many think it says “heal” but it says “save.” The verse goes on to say the Lord will “raise” the sick up, which implies healing, but it was mentioned after “save” was stated. God always puts the higher priority on salvation from sin, over the lesser priority of physical healing from sickness. Notice what the Bible says happens for the sick when he is anointed and prayed for by the Elders: “if he have committed <u>sins</u>, they shall be forgiven him.” Being “healed” is finally mentioned in verse 16, which shows we should confess our faults and pray one for another to be healed, as “the effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.” It was so beautiful and humbling to see the family of CAC praying one for another.</p>	<p>Junior Elder Rusty Sandy preached on building a church using Matthew 16:18. God is our healer and provider. We need to build strong foundations so when the enemy comes against us we’ll be able to stand. The world puts up a barrier – what do you want to do or not do. Too often, people put “things” before God – games, pleasures, food, absence from church. A man sick of the palsy was brought to Jesus. Jesus saw their faith, healed the man and forgave him of his sins. Don’t give up. God is with us. Be glad, rejoice and sing praises to God. Make sure you’re built on a strong foundation. We can shake off anything with Jesus. Don’t build a barrier. We are not a dead church. God has brought us too far to give up. Let everything that hath breath praise the Lord! Make a joyful noise unto Him. When the devil tries to come between you and God, don’t listen to him. You need to praise God. You can be used for God’s work. Pray for more faith and strength to be used of God.</p>

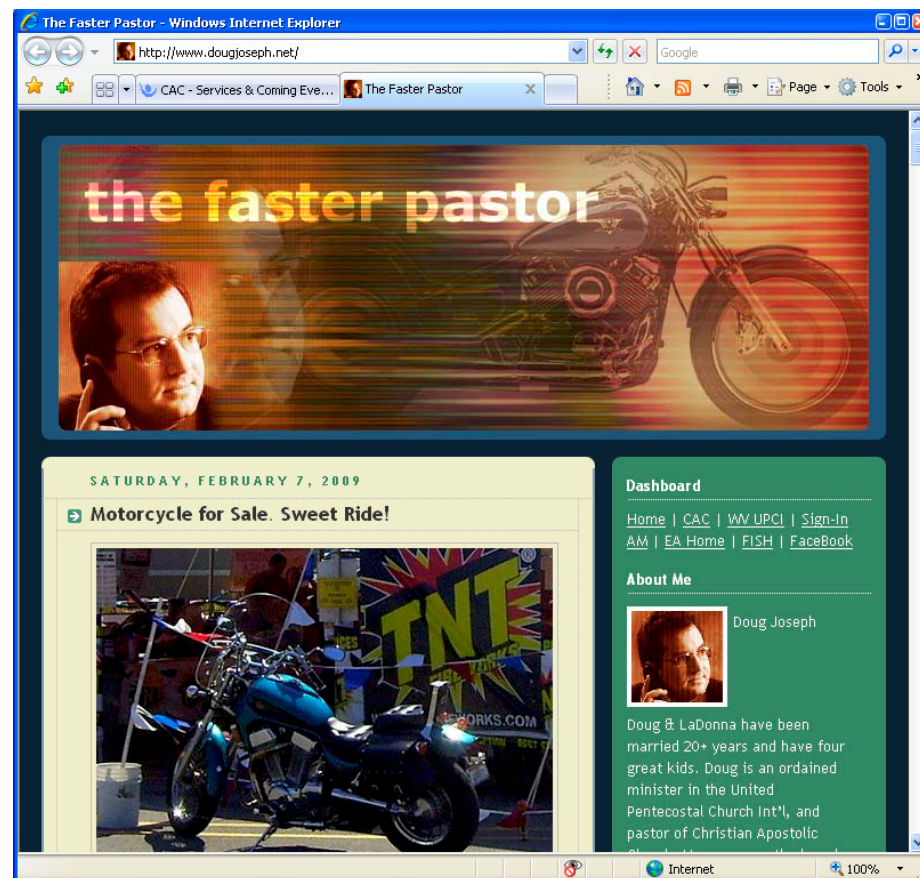
