Perfect love casts out fear. <i>Keep your eyes on Jesus! He never fails us.</i></p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught a lesson on leadership. He based his lesson on wording in Matthew 28:19. When the Son of man came (Christ Jesus, our Lord and Savior), He did not seek to tear down or destroy the works or writings of earlier men of God, such as Moses and the prophets. He did not come to build some “new foundation” apart from the foundation already laid by the prophets who had come before Him. Rather, he completed their foundation. He said, “Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil” (Matthew 5:17). Likewise, we must not envy or despise those who build upon our good works after we’ve moved on to something else, and we should not disparage those who serve after us, or those who served before us. One sows, another waters. Pastor Joseph also taught about the history and proper interpretation of Matthew 28:19. Jesus is the name of the Father, and Son, and Holy Ghost. In the Book of Acts, baptism was done in Jesus name.</p>

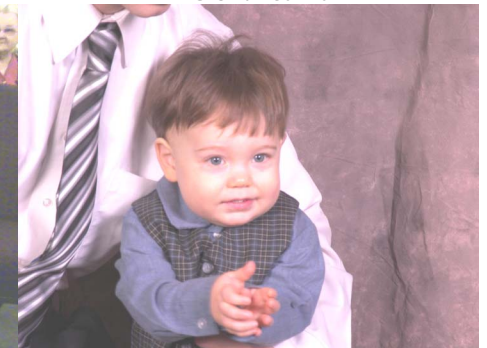

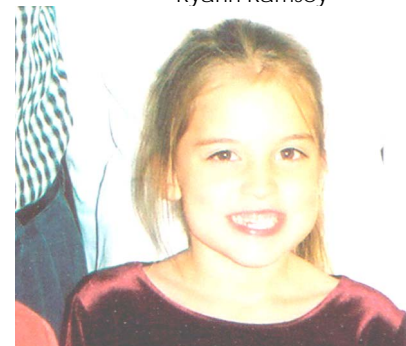

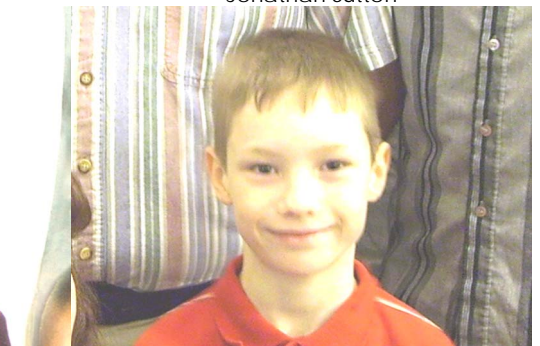
