<p>Bro. Earl Rodeheaver preached "I Am Not Crazy; I Am Desperate" using Acts 26:22-25. When Paul came to God he was a forever-changed man. All men who truly come to God will be changed. "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new" (I Corinthians 5:17). Some people will think we're crazy when we tell them of our experience. Apostle Paul told Festus, "I am not mad." He was just desperate to do something for God. The church needs a sense of desperation; we need a return of old-time Pentecost. Be what God wants you to be. Be conformed to God. It's all about Jesus. Paul was just concerned about reaching the lost. He was desperate to see God move. He was not worried about being famous, or rich, or well-liked in this world. He only wanted to "know him, and the power of his resurrection" (Phil.3:10). When the devil puts us to a test, are we really who we say we are? We must be desperate. If we want to see revival we must be desperate for God. We need to get to the place where we pray and wait on God to do something. Just as in the parable of the wedding feast, people will make excuses why they can't come to church. Excuses, excuses, excuses! People can think of a thousand reasons to stay home from church. We need to get desperate. When you get desperate for God He'll change your world – you'll see healings, you'll see souls saved, you'll see your financial needs met. Let your focus in life be on Jesus. Be desperate!</p>	<p>Youth Pastor Lorren Godwin taught using Mark 4:35-41. When Jesus stilled the storm at sea, His disciples said, "What manner of man is this, that even the wind and sea obey Him?" We respect God for He is greater than us. If we step out closer to Him we'll accomplish more. Sometimes we're afraid to step out thinking people will make fun of us. We need to step out in faith, saying, I want a relationship with Jesus. Be desperate. Sometimes we start out excited like Peter was when he walked on the water. When Peter took his eyes off Jesus, he fell. We need to not fear when storms come, the winds blow, the thunder rolls and the lightning flashes in our lives. Jesus is with us in our storm. He won't always stop the storm, but He will see us through. When we step out in faith God will not leave us. He is God of the storm.</p>


