

<p>Pastor Joseph taught using Mark 16: 1-11. We personally need Jesus in us by His Spirit so we can witness about Him. Although we were born with a sin curse, still we are all responsible for our sins. Genetics are not to blame for one kind of sin any more than another. No one wants to take the blame for their sins. Adam blamed Eve and Eve blamed the serpent. We must be responsible for our sins. If you have not gotten your nature changed by God, you are sinning by nature. God gives us remission of sins. This helps cleanse your worldview. God tells us what is right and wrong. Your worldview matters. If you haven't repented, been baptized in Jesus name and received the Holy Ghost, then your worldview is upside down and your nature is wrong. We, as parents, must teach our children to be Christian believers. But all must seek to be transformed so we may be conformed to Jesus' character. Nothing we do earns salvation. JESUS IS ALIVE. He did rise from the dead.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught "How Did Jesus Die?" using Psalm 22:1-24. "Christ died for our sins" (I Corinthians 15:3). Jesus hung on the cross. It was a long, slow, agonizing, torturing death. He was beaten, scourged, spat upon; more than any man could take. Out of respect for the coming Sabbath, the Roman soldiers sought to hasten death for those being crucified. Jesus was pierced by a spear to make sure He was dead and out flowed blood and water. He did not just give up. He didn't die of a broken heart. He was killed, slaughtered. Jesus was our Passover Lamb. After three days and three nights He was resurrected. Our Saviour lived a sinless life and died an undeserved death. He always submitted to God's will, never once disobeying. In the Garden of Gethsemane He subdued His human will and obeyed. When Thomas saw His hands and His feet he cried, "My Lord and my God." Because of what He did for us at Calvary, we should live our life close to Him.</p>	<p>Elder Lorren Godwin taught from Numbers 11:1-6. Carnal nature can cause us to get upset when we don't get our way. This can cause division in the church. God blessed the children of Israel as they traveled through the wilderness, and yet they complained. They were a blessed people and yet they forgot to be thankful. The Lord destroyed some of them because of their murmuring and complaining. Don't get caught up in things that don't matter. Stay focused on things that do matter. What do people see when they read your life like a book? The human heart is deceitful. Don't be ruled by your flesh. We must die daily. Everyone wants to live on the mountaintop. When we go through trials, we don't have to take on the enemy by ourselves. Turn to God and He will help us be victorious. What does God see when He searches our hearts? The Psalmist wrote, "Create in me a clean heart." The Lord Jesus taught "Seek ye first the kingdom of God."</p>
