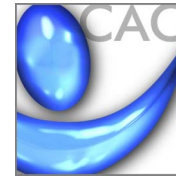

Jarius went to Jesus seeking help because his daughter lay home at the point of death. Can He? Does He care? Will He come with me? YES. As Jesus was making His way to Jarius' house, a woman with an issue of blood pressed herself through the crowd to touch Jesus. The doctors had given up on her but she said, "If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be made whole." We need to do everything within our power to touch Jesus. God blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning. <i>On this night God did a great healing.</i></p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught "Relationships, Part 3: Love" using John 13:34-35 as his text. The goal of a Christian is to become conformed to the character of Christ. God is the foundation of love. We love Him because He first loved us. Then, we love our spouse, and our children and parents. Children must obey their parents, and always (even when they are older) honor them, which means to treat them as precious. We are to love our church family, our extended family, friends, and neighbors. We must love even our enemies. Only if we stay prayed up and full of the Holy Ghost will our love be adequate. Love is a choice, a commitment expressed by actions more than feelings. Love is: patient, kind, not envious, not boastful, not proud, not rude, not self-seeking, not easily angered, does not keep a record of wrongs, does not delight in evil, but in truth, bears (protects), believes (trusts), hopes and endures. Love never fails. Love is to be expressed both verbally and in kind actions.</p>

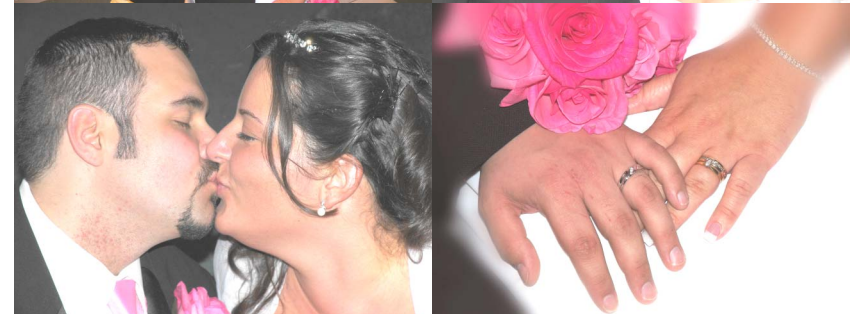
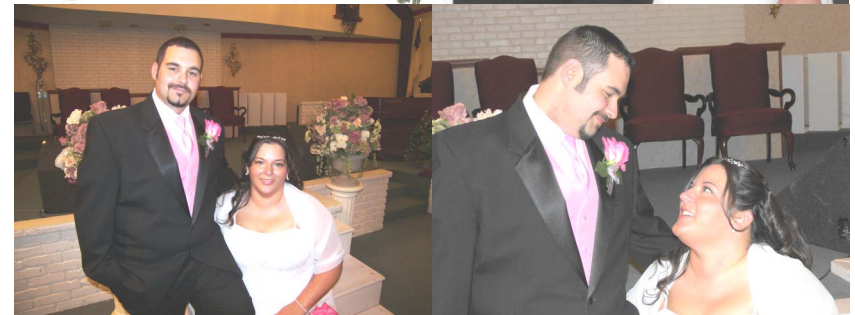
