<p>Associate Pastor David Harris, Jr preached "Stand Your Ground" using II Chronicles 20:17. When God's people were at war, God told them to stand and see the salvation of the Lord. We need to stand in what we believe in. We are losing old time prophets. We need to hold on to what they taught us. People in these last days don't like to hear the preaching of God's word. But we must stand up for what God has told us. We must be separate from the world in our dress, talk, actions, etc. Stand for God and let the world know that you won't give in. Delilah enticed Samson over and over again until he gave in and told her what made him strong. Don't lose your anointing – Holy Ghost – strength. Stand strong in the Lord. Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego stood for the Lord when they were told to bow before the golden image or be cast into a fiery furnace. God delivered them. The plan of salvation is real. Let's stand for God's word.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "Upload Complete" using James 4:1-17. What is your life? Life is short. It is a vapor. Man has no promise of tomorrow. We have dreams of what we want to be but often we never get around to it. What does God want from us? More than just coming to church. But we need to seize every opportunity we can to teach the truth to someone. We need to teach and instill God's truth into our children. Just bringing them to church isn't enough. We must teach them God's word. God made all of us capable of telling someone about salvation. We all have the potential for greatness. Abraham taught God's word to his children. Consider your life, from the time you were born until the time you will die. What are you doing to make life worth living? All that matters in our lifetime is what we do for God. Are we living a faithful life for God? How many people have we won for God? Our hope is to obtain a crown that will never fade away.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught "Trusting God" using Exodus 16:1-5, 11-26. While we cannot control whether someone accepts truth, we can control whether we tell them. Outreach success is within our reach. For church growth, we need to attract, win, and retain people, all in a godly way. The church is a spiritual mother. This must be a place where sinners can be touched by God's Spirit. He that winneth souls is wise. We are to win people to us so we can influence them toward God. When people are first filled with the Holy Ghost they are like a newborn baby. They need a lot of care, love and teaching. Be a friend. Invite them to dinner. Our goal is not only to win souls but to retain them. Other areas that affect church growth include ministerial ethics, use of money and use of power. Trusting in God helps us avoid dangerous personal flaws and problems. Be what you're supposed to be. We are not called to be successful, but rather <i>faithful</i> to our calling, our message, and people.</p>

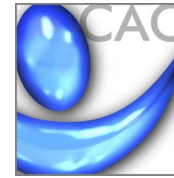
