# Christian Apostolic Church Community of the Redeemed

Exploring the American Roots of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century Renewal of the Pentecostal Outpouring of the Spirit!



Charles Fox Parham (June 4, 1873 – Jan. 29, 1929) was an American preacher who was instrumental in the formation of Pentecostalism. Also a movement of independent Apostolic Faith "Missions" (churches) grew across the southern and western US from meetings Parham held. He founded Bethel Bible College (at right) in Topeka, Kansas, operating the school on a faith basis, not charging tuition, depending on God to supply all their needs.





Agnes Ozman (1870 - 1937) was a female student at Parham's Bethel Bible School in Topeka, Kansas. She was considered by many\* as "the first to speak in tongues," and her experience sparked the modern Pentecostal-Holiness movement, which began in the early 20th century. (\*She was not the first to speak in tongues in modern history, but other earlier outpourings were not as widely known, and her experience became a catalyst of Pentecostal renewal in the 20th century.) Parham and all his other students were also soon filled!



William Joseph Seymour (May 2, 1870 - Sept 28, 1922) was an African American minister and an initiator of the Pentecostal religious movement. He was born the son of freed slaves in Centerville, Louisiana. In 1905, Charles Parham moved his Bible school to Houston, Texas (see right). There,



Seymour (who was then a minister in his mid-30s) met Parham and became his student. Although Seymour did not receive the Holy Ghost then, he became convinced that *speaking in tongues* was the biblical evidence of the Holy Spirit baptism. He was later invited to

Los Angeles to try out for a church in need of a pastor. When he preached about tongues there, they locked him out! The Richard Asbury family took him in, and they began daily prayer meetings and Bible study in the Asbury home, located at 214 North Bonnie Brae Street (see right). There, Seymour



and the Asbury's were filled! People began to come to the house by the hundreds, and he preached from the porch to an overfilled yard. They needed a larger place to continue the work. They found a run-down building in downtown Los Angeles, located at 312 Azusa Street *(see right)*, and there they had church *every day* for about 3 and a half hears! During the Azusa Street revival, thousands were filled. The "color line" (racism) was washed away by the blood. Many



great miracles happened. Missionaries came and went. The fire spread around the world!
