Brother Norris brought volunteers from the crowd and had the first one demonstrate a person drowning in the depths of the sea. This is what a lost man is like without God's salvation. Bro. Norris then had each succeeding volunteer represent the various false religions of the world. Some scold or chide, others instruct or brag, and others debate and philosophize. But none truly help or offer salvation. For example, Buddhism says, "Maybe you will have better luck in future reincarnations." TM (Transcendental Meditation) tells us to, "Imagine a solution and meditate and maybe it will happen." Only Jesus Christ truly helps us. Only the truth of His gospel brings effective


salvation. Praise God!
