<p>Associate Pastor David Harris preached "An Altar in the Midst of Egypt" from Isaiah 19:19. Egypt is a symbol of this world. We must have an altar in our life while we are in the midst of this world. We are in a prophetically charged hour. Prophecies about the end time are coming to pass before our very eyes. If we don't have a prayer life, and stay in a strong relationship with Jesus, we won't make it very far in this current hour. Egyptians had many gods; a god for everything. This world is steeped in superstition and false religions. In these days, those who truly serve the living God will see God's power manifested. In the midst of many altars built unto false gods, it is God's will that His people build an altar unto the true and living God. If we will cry out in prayer unto God, He will move on our behalf. Just as the Jews cried out in slavery, and saw God send Moses to them as a savior, if we cry out to God, Jesus will manifest Himself in our presence. Let Egypt see our altar and know God!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "Calling Upon the Name of the Lord - Part 2" using Acts 2:21. Biblical illiteracy is a serious blight in America today. Because people are largely ignorant about what the Bible has to say in its entirety, they then form false doctrines, and go about arrogantly declaring their view to be correct. Some people grossly misinterpret the verses that say that those who call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved. In Acts 19, a group of men called upon the name of the Lord without having a real relationship with God, and they suffered a terrible defeat with great shame and disgrace. The Lord did not deliver them. Why? Simply calling verbally upon God without being a whole-hearted seeker of Him will do no good. A careful study of all the verses pertaining to calling on the Lord's name, show that the meaning of that phrase includes much more than such preachers claim. It involves obedience, witnessing, thanksgiving, worship & righteousness.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught a study of Romans 6 & 7 entitled "Will the Real Me Please Stand Up." Humans are dual-nature creatures, being both spirit and flesh. Our carnal nature (or flesh nature) is referred to as the outward man. Our spirit is referred to as the inner man or inward man. Some wrong views of Christianity include (1) the false idea that a redeemed person will never suffer temptation to sin and can never commit a sin; and (2) the notion that a Christian's outward man can sin at will without having any effect of condemnation or damage to the inner man, and (3) the lie that a Christian's outward man, or carnal nature, is already fully redeemed in this life and no longer subject to the law of sin and death. A study of Romans debunks all such false notions. With the inner man we serve God, but until the Rapture, the law of sin and death is at work in our members. We must be mindful that in our flesh is no good thing. Be on guard. Keep the flesh in check (which requires the help of God.)</p>


