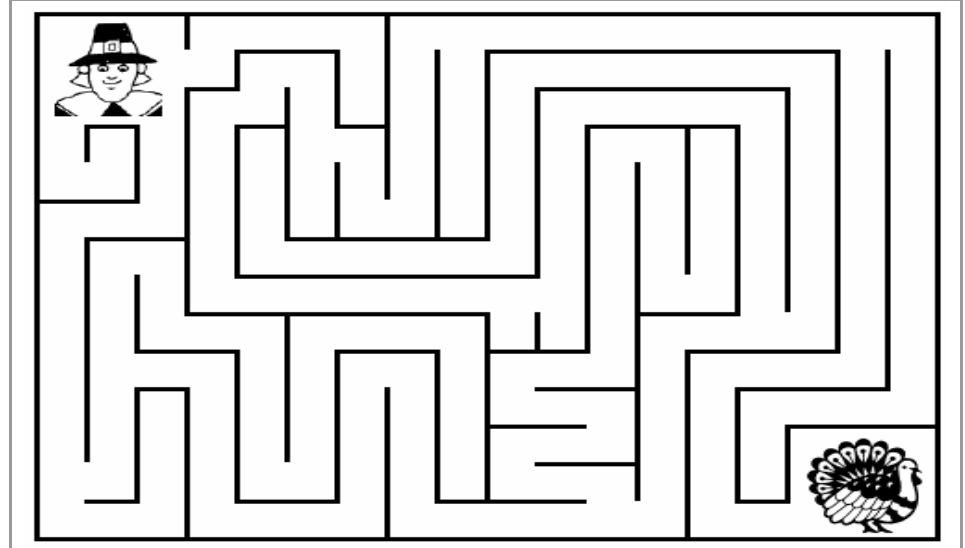

<p>Pastor Joseph preached "The Righteousness Which is By Faith" using Genesis 7:5 & Hebrews 11:1-8. Noah found grace in the eyes of God. Grace is <i>unearned</i> favor, or <i>undeserved</i> blessing. Noah did not earn the blueprint for the Ark, but he did believe God, and he obeyed what God commanded him to do. So he was listed in Hebrews 11, in what is called the Hall of Faith. We cannot earn salvation. Righteousness is not earned by living perfectly, but rather it comes by faith! Of the Hebrews 11 "heroes of faith" all of them made mistakes, but they had faith! They believed God! Paul the Apostle wrote, "The good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do." We must do our best, but also realize that our imperfect track record will not cost us entrance to heaven if we believe God to help us, for His grace to make up for where we fall short. If we believe God, He will give to us His very own righteousness. We don't deserve it. Do not use grace as a license to sin.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "The Hit Man in The House of Solomon" using II Samuel 7:11-17 & I Kings 2:1-9, 25, 28-29, 34-36, 44-46. God made a promise to David that his throne would be established forever, which was a prophetic reference to Jesus, but it also allowed for others of David's descendants to rule. David chose that his son Solomon would be the next king. Yet Solomon's elder brother, Adonijah, tried to steal the throne. Benaiah was Solomon's "hit man." He took out the wicked enemies Adonijah, Joab, and Shimei. Pastor Joseph likened those three to (1) our flesh, (2) the world, and (3) the devil. These will take you to Hell if you let them. At the altar, we must die out to sin, flesh, and the world. Thank God that His salvation comes by regeneration. He can change us and "kill off" the parts of us that need to die. Our enemies lure us with the promise of worldly pleasures. Don't listen. The flesh is tricky; it can't be trusted. It must be killed by the hit man.</p>	<p>The singing evangelists, Brother Dave and Sister Bonita Petersen, were with us here at CAC, and they ministered to us in anointed singing and with exhortation by the Scriptures. Due to certain situations, there was a felt need in the hearts of several of the saints, and the church members ministered to one another wonderfully and with great compassion, being empowered by the Spirit of God. Thank God for His blessings and help, and for the wonderful church with which He has blessed us.</p>

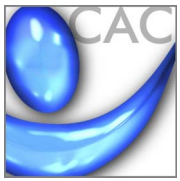

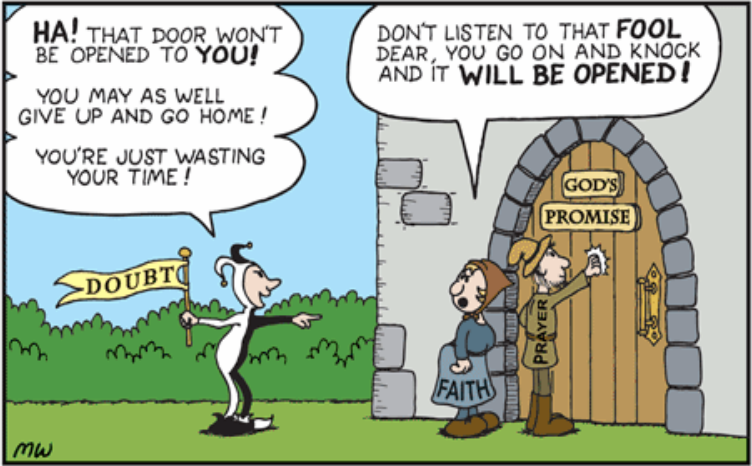
