In chapter 13, when he wanted to bring the ark of the covenant home, he inquired of the people but not of God, so the effort was not a success. He learned a valuable lesson. In their conflict with the Philistines. David inquired of the Lord. God gave the answer and victory. To inquire also means to give an invitation. Since David could ask of God, then so can we. 



30 Days of Prayer - Tips from prior days (see more online).

Day 1	Day 6	
Day 1: Get a spiral of 3" x 5" ruled index cards from Walmart for \$1.28. On each card carefully write down (with a bold black marker) the various names of people for whom you pray on a regular basis.	Day 6: If it is worth praying for, it certainly is worth writing down. Habakkuk 2:2 "Write the vision and make it plain upon tables that he may run that readeth it." Write it down the prophet says! Get that spiral of index cards.	
Day 2	Day 7	
Day 2: God is looking for individuals who will be messengers to their generation. Pray for God to help you be that messenger.	Day 7: Pray to break the grip of materialism upon our lives that prevents us from pursuing God without hesitation and self-imposed limitations.	
Day 3	Day 8	
Day 3: Approach God with tears and an honest, open heart and say, "Lord, I believe; help my unbelief," Jesus will reply as He did in Mark 9:23: "All things are possible to him that believes."	Day 8: Has life's disappointment and disillusionment made you somewhat hardhearted? It may be that you do not feel the tenderness you once did. Ask the Lord to make you tenderhearted and forgiving so you can minister to others.	
Day 4	Day 9	
Day 4: Pray as the disciples in Luke 17:5: "Lord, increase our faith. We repent of unbelief and pray that You would teach us through experience what it means to believe unreservedly in You. We pray as our faith increases you will act upon it."	Day 9: D. L. Moody said, "It remains to be seen what God will do with a man who gives himself up wholly to Him." Submit wholly to God and watch what He accomplishes through you.	
Day 5	Day 10	
Day 5: God is concerned about your individual needs, not just the world. Pray He will show you your needs and weaknesses. When you are weak, then you are strongbecause of His strength and enablement.	Day 10: is today! If you have already joined us in prayer and fasting, thank you. If you have not yet, consider joining in as much as you can in the remaining 20 days. God will help us with revival. We need His help!
