



<p>Associate Pastor David Harris preached "God Holds Your Hand" using Isaiah 45:1-3 &amp; 42:5-6. Your problem may seem worse to you because you're the one with it. Over time in your walk with God you will notice that being mature through the trial isn't always possible. The reason for this is because maturity comes at the end of a trial just as knowing comes at the end of the lesson. God will hold your hand through the trial, and bring you through. It's incredible what God will do when you follow Him through the fire. The Bible states that we will be tried as gold. The purification of gold is accomplished with intense heat. Gold can be made so pure it becomes translucent. Being made pure requires great heat. We need to have true repentance. That is when we change and never commit that sin. Becoming pure gold means we don't purposely sin, and that we continue to strive for perfection. It is a process until we die or are caught up with Him. We won't be able to "truly repent" unless we are holding God's hand.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached a message entitled "Why Johnny Lingo Paid Eight Cows for His Wife." The message could easily have been titled "Oh How He Loves Us" (regarding the great love that Jesus has for His bride, the Church). It was a very fitting message for Valentine's Day, and it was a great encouragement to God's people. The true story of Johnny Lingo and Sarita, his wife, was published over 44 years ago. A young woman who is not valued by her parents and the people around her feels worthless. This causes her to carry herself in a low, stooped manner, and to appear plain to all who see her. Such was the case for poor Sarita, but Johnny Lingo saw past this, and saw her true beauty. No other man on those remote Pacific islands would have paid more than one cow for her, but Johnny paid more for her than any father had ever received. This made her to know his great love for her and caused her true beauty to shine. <b>Jesus bought us with his blood &amp; death. He paid more than can ever be described. What love!</b></p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught on "Men as Servant-Leaders." For his text, he read Matthew 20:28 and Ephesians 5:23, 25. Our culture has spent more than two decades redefining the roles of husband and wife. False notions abound. The Bible does say that the husband is the head of the wife, but what does that mean? The Bible illustrates the kind of servant leadership that a man ought to show by comparing a man's headship to Christ who is the head of the church. Men are to love their wife as also Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her. A man ought not to think it means his wife must obey his every whim without question. The Scriptures clearly give us the model for being not only a man, but also a husband and father. It's the "servant-leader" model that Jesus Himself exemplified. The husband and father is to lead, love and serve his wife and family. Some men cannot understand the biblical definition of a leader as a servant. Even though He was Lord, Jesus said, "The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve."</p>



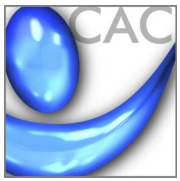

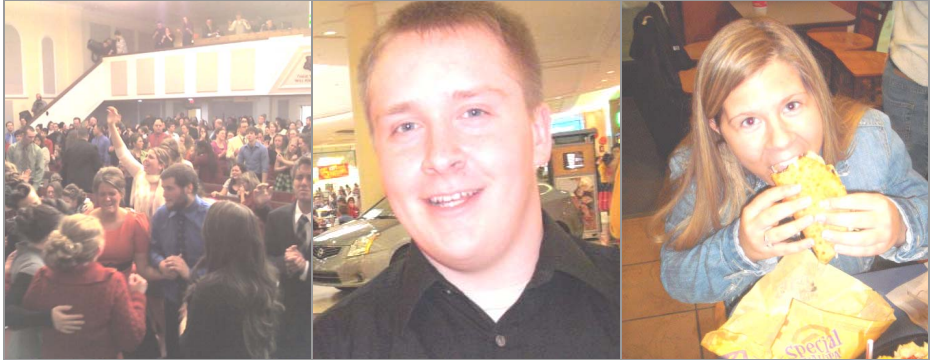
