Associate Pastor David Harris preached "Revival Is Here, Let's Be Apostolic!" using Romans 15: 18-19. In the day and hour in which we are living we must be Apostolic. Pastor Joseph preached "Relationship Over Riches" using I Samuel 30:1-6. When all was lost, David did not turn away from God. Instead, David encouraged himself in the Lord. Many people followed Jesus only for the miracles, for the loaves and fish, and when Jesus taught them the Word they turned away from Him. We must have a relationship with Jesus. When the night is the darkest, hold onto Jesus. Job lost everything except for his wife, yet he loved God in his bad times as well as his good times. He stood his ground when he was tested because he had a relationship with God. Economic times separate the wheat from the chaff. Love God more than material things. Your heart is where your treasure is. Don't let money be your primary goal. Make Jesus your goal. Have a relationship with Him.


