He is to be baptized this Wednesday!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "Heavenly Wisdom Vs. Earthly Wisdom" using James 3:13-18. There are two kinds of "wisdom"—one from above that is good, and another that is carnal and/or demonic and which is very dangerous. "There is a way that seems right to a man, but in the end it leads to death" (Prov. 16:25). "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?" (Jer. 17:9). People will try to justify their ways but the "earthly wisdom" is sensual and devilish. God has granted unto man a broad range of freedoms to make choices, yet God does not permit freedom from the consequences of our choices, except through the salvation provided by Jesus' death on the cross. We are as the prodigal son, who had the freedom to choose to live a worldly life, yet the consequences of his actions left him destitute, and so starved he was ready to eat pig slop. We need to discern the true wisdom that is from above, which comes from God's Spirit, because the "earthly wisdom" is tricky and conniving. If one practices (consistently) the normal spiritual disciplines (such as prayer, fasting, church attendance, worship, and Bible study) then our inward man (the spirit nature) will be strong and the outward man (the carnal nature) will be weak. Then whenever an occasion for sin or stumbling comes along, you can overcome it by God's help. We must embrace the wisdom of God. Hug it! Cling to it! It is a tree of life! Love God and maintain your communication Him and with God's people. Being concerned the most about what <i>I</i> want is using "earthly wisdom." True wisdom is caring more about God's will than about our own will. If you lack the heavenly wisdom, then pray and ask God for it. The Bible promises: "If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him" (James 1:5 KJV).</p>
