| <p>Pastor Joseph preached a special Mother's Day sermon entitled "Women With Worth." For his text he read Matthew 1:3, 5, 6, 16. His message was especially suited for today's mothers, but the principles apply to all of us. The text shows the genealogy of Jesus through His legal father, Joseph. Unlike typical genealogies of that day, this one names five notable women in God's covenant: Tamar (a victim who was also a transgressor, yet she was in the covenant); Rahab (a Canaanite, an immoral woman, far from God, who came into the covenant by faith); Ruth (a Moabite, a good woman, not far from God, who became a woman of faith); Bathsheba (an adulteress, yet she was in the covenant); and Mary (the mother of Jesus, a godly woman). Thus we see represented women of every background and of every experience. Just as each obtained mercy and obtained a place in God's plan, so it can be for any woman, or in fact any person. Your past can be forgiven, and you can be honored as one of worth.</p> | <p>Associate Pastor David Harris Jr. preached "I Have Chosen and Ordained You" using John 15:16, Isaiah 61:3 and Psalms 45:7 & 23:5-6. The anointing you got when you received the Holy Ghost is the same today. He has called and chosen us to go forth as shining lights in this world. The anointing of the Holy Ghost is priceless; it is more precious than gold. We need to have His anointing from the soles of our feet to the top of our head. We have this oil of gladness. If we hold this oil inside of us, it will get stagnant. We need to let it overflow. Paul told Timothy that without ceasing he has prayed for him. Folks, somebody is praying for you all the time. We need to stir up the gift of God that is within us. The world doesn't have this anointing as we do. We need to share it any chance that we have with all of our strength and might.</p> | <p>Pastor Joseph preached "How Well Are We Listening to the Lord?" using Heb. 12:1-8 & 13:5-9, 16-18 & Psalm 116:1-2. We are compassed with a great cloud of witnesses, so we must lay aside every weight and sin. Don't be weary in well doing or get discouraged in faith. Consider what Jesus went through for us. Trust is the most valuable asset a Christian has. We ought to obey those who have rule over us for they are giving us the Word of God. A disobedient life is a troubled life. If you live that kind of life, you will reap consequences. God always hears us. Liken God's love to the love a father has for his child. He wants what's best for us just as a dad does his son.</p> |
