If we do this we will win this race.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "Ascending Vapors" using Psalm 135:7 as his main text. In order to provide rain to water the earth there must be vapors ascending all over the earth. When vapor sticks to vapor it becomes rain. Then it comes down and blesses the earth. Not only does this cycle sustain physical life on earth, it is a type of the spreading of His Word. He said His Word shall go forth out of His mouth and will not return unto Him void. Rain represents God's Word coming down before fulfillment, while vapor represents God's Word returning to Him with, or after, fulfillment. Just as vapor must stick to vapor to become rain, so also righteous friends must cleave to righteous friends to become a godly rain of Christian influence in order to bless the world. We must go to the world as rain, not wanting to be of the world, like the world, or loving the world's value system. Friendship with the world is enmity with God. Friends shape friends, friends love each other, and friends stick together. Godly people will have godly friends. We must be holy on the inside and out.</p>




