Last Sunday

Pastor Joseph preached "When I Reach My True Love" using Genesis 24:61-67. How can one know when he or she has found true love? This is a question so many people ask. PRAY to find true love. When you pray, have faith that God is going to show you. Listen for the voice of God, and then when God speaks to you to tell you the answer, get up and do something about it. Real faith requires obedience. Worldly people think dating lots of people is the way to find true love, but that fails miserably. But if you pray and get guidance from God, then you don't have to date lots of people to find true love. God will show you who you are to marry if you'll pray and ask Him. Don't place confidence in the flesh. There's too much at stake in your future and reputation. If you aren't ready to get married, why date? Marriage is an institution of God, and when you get God's help in choosing your mate, marriage can be one of the most fulfilling things you can do in this life. Speaking of which, marriage between a man and a woman is a covenant that pertains to *this life*, not to eternity. When two people marry, it is "until death do us part." The Bible clearly teaches that death ends the earthly marriage covenant. Don't waste your time, energy, purity, and potential future by doing dating & marriage the world's way. Approach romance, love, dating and marriage by doing it God's way. Rebekah and Isaac got married the first day they met, the very same day they saw each other for the first time. The marriage was a success. How can this be? There was prayer to God, guidance from God, obedience to God, and the blessing of God. The very first time Rebekah saw Isaac, she quickly dismounted from the back of her camel because she trusted—she knew—this was the man that God had for her to marry. That's faith. True love and successful marriage is such a sacred matter that nothing less than prayer and God's help should be acceptable to you. So let us pray and seek God for direction in our lives.
