<p>Pastor Joseph preached “The Prime of Life” using Hebrews 11:1-3, 23-32 & Exodus 2:11-15. Today’s culture worships youth but despises the wisdom of age. Worldly culture advocates no respect for parents, pastor, or older adults in general. The strength and beauty of youth are treated as superior, although lacking experience and wisdom. Moses, during his youth, attempted to help his oppressed people by murdering an Egyptian. When Pharaoh sought to slay him he fled into the land of Midian There he became a husband, father and a keeper of sheep. He became the meekest man on earth. He later realized that wisdom, experience, and the help of God are much better than the strength and zeal of youth. He accomplished more for God’s people during the last third of his life (from 80 years old to 120 years old) than he did during his youth and middle age put together. We thank God for the zeal of the church’s young people, but we need our older adults, who are in their prime regarding wisdom and experience. Wisdom is more powerful than the strength of youth. The church needs both youth and older people.</p>	<p>Sis. Hannah Fryzel preached using John 1:4-7. God’s light is shining to all men. No matter how deep in sin you are His light is shining for you. He’s always there. He’s awesome!</p> <p>Pastor Joseph preached “Your Greatest Enemy” using I Corinthians 12:31, 13:1-3. God’s toughest obstacle in saving you is <i>yourself</i>. The devil is not our biggest problem; when we have the Holy Ghost and are baptized in Jesus name we have authority to rebuke the devil. We are representatives of Jesus with all His power. The devil isn’t the problem, our flesh is. We must be disciplined and keep our flesh under subjection. People wrestle with God’s Word trying to make it fit their flesh – they are ever learning yet never able to come to the Truth. We cannot earn our own salvation. After doing the best we can, we must ask “What lack I yet?” All our righteousness is as filthy rags to God. If we let our flesh dominate our spirit, it will take us to hell. 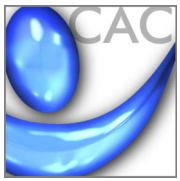
