<p>Former Pastor Terry Null preached "The Moments of Wonder in the Presence of God" using Luke 10:38-42 & Psalm 107. Give thanks and praise to God, for His mercy endures forever. Without His mercy and grace there is no redemption for our sins. Praise God for His goodness and the mighty works He has done for you. We have wonderful "God-moments" in our lives. Many times the children of Israel cried out in distress. God gave them many moments of wonder, such as parting the Red Sea and turning the bitter water into sweet water at Marah. God will give you moments of wonder when you're going through a trial. When life stings you and spins you around, when you're seeing but can't see; when you're hearing but can't hear; when you think you can't make it through the day – think of your mighty God and recall the moments of wonder in your life. The wonders of God are not limited to the sanctuary but can be at the hospital or your home. Martha received Jesus into her home, then she dismissed Him. Mary received Him and was at His feet taking in those moments of wonder. Jesus told Martha that Mary had chosen "that good part."</p>	<p>Former Pastor Terry Null preached "Faith" using II Kings 4:2-7. Faith is a fuse connected to God's promises. It only needs someone to light it. When the devil throws things at you, faith has a way of destroying those things that come against you. If God didn't think you could do a thing, He wouldn't have revealed it to you. When you seek to exercise your faith, you need to have your mind made up that you won't give up until you receive what you need. The world may foreclose on people, but God is going to take care of His own. God is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think. God has a plan. The Bible says, "a sinner's wealth is stored up for the righteous" (Prov. 13:22). When in despair, find someone you can connect with. In her despair, the widow went to Elisha, the man of God. She obeyed the words of Elisha. She borrowed vessels and poured her last pot of oil into the vessels. Thus, she lit the fuse of faith. He told her to "pay the debt and live thou and thy children of the rest." God can always meet our needs.</p>	<p>Elder David Harris preached using Isaiah 43:1-9. Sometimes in life, the flow of things is against God and godliness. This is due to sin and the cursed state of creation. In such times, we must go against the flow and resist evil. At other times, God causes a sovereign flow of healing waters by the anointing of His Spirit. At such times we are wise to go with the flow and measure and enjoy what God is doing. At times God will change things for us (back on the brink) while we are out in the water. God loves us. We are precious to Him. When we are having trials and walking through the fire He will help us be victorious. We need to get deeper and closer to Jesus. His Word is Truth and we need more and more of Him.</p>
