

<p>Elder David Harris Jr. preached “A Father of Fate” using Mark 5:22-24 & 35-39. Working miracles and doing the works of God was Jesus’ life. Our carnal mind wants us to give up on our faith. It will give us the wrong understanding of what’s going on. Faith works every day in our lives. Sometimes we don’t see it happening. When we do what God tells us to do, He will bless us. He always provides for His people. God owns the cattle on a thousand hills. Have faith and trust in God. He will supply your every need. Jesus told Jairus “Be not afraid, only believe.” When we have a problem we need to have faith and believe that God is able to do all things. We must trust that Jesus loves us and cares for us. Faith is when you wake feeling terrible, yet you still say “I’m going to do something for Jesus today.” Do we rely on what goes into our checking account? Or do we rely on who owns it? Jesus Christ owns it. God’s word lets us know that Jesus is coming soon. We must have faith and believe that we are going to be caught up to meet Him in the air.</p>	<p>Elder David Harris Jr. preached “God’s Word and Its Power” using John 1:1-5 & 11-12. God’s Word is powerful. Ezekiel had a vision of dry bones. He was asked if these bones could live. Yes! God’s Word is so powerful that things thought impossible will happen. His Word has unlimited strength! His Word is amazing! “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.” God (by His Word) spoke this world into existence. We need to read His Word, declare it, and memorize it. The world may be able to take other things away from us, but they can never take God’s Word from us. If we really have a desire to change, then God will reveal His Word to us. When we have a problem and something needs fixed, we need to go to His Word. He’s the One who is able to do anything. He knows exactly where we are and what we are going through. God’s Word will take care of it. His Word will bless us. Every time we read it we will find something new and inspiring. We need to have faith and believe that God’s Word is powerful.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached “The Change” using Isaiah 44:24 & John 8:16, 16:32. Here are some colossal truths. 1) God is one. 2) He never changes. 3) A change occurred in the moment God manifested Himself in flesh, yet it did not represent a change in the nature, character or oneness of God. When God and the man Jesus stand in unison, is not two men, nor is it two Gods, nor is it two God-persons. It is “one God and one man.” A change from “not manifested in flesh” to being “manifested in flesh” does not mean any change at all in the pre-existing God’s character or personality. Jesus is the unique Son of God. He is not the manifestation of one third of God, nor is He the manifestation of just one out of three God-persons. In Jesus dwells all the fulness of the Deity in bodily form.</p>


