Vanuatu consists of about 80 small islands in the South Pacific, near to Australia. Although cannibalistic natives have lived on the islands since before history was kept, some of the islands were named by the explorers that discovered them. One of the islands is named "Pentecost" (it was discovered on Pentecost Sunday by Captain Cook), and another is named "Espiritu Santo" (which is Spanish & means "Holy Spirit"). During World War II the U.S. forces established a base in these islands. Sister Long spoke and sung in Bislama Pidgen English, which is the most common language of Vanuatu and the official language for most of it. She read John 8:12 and sang "How Great Thou Art." It was awesome! Brother Long ministered to us using Psalm 37:3-5. When we give a sacrifice of praise to God, He will bless us. We should enjoy the Lord. "Delight thyself also in the Lord; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart." Be faithful to the house of God. You get power when you come together with God's people, and God will bless you if you are faithful. Put God first in everything you do. Brother Long testified of how God brought him from a life where he knew nothing about this Pentecostal message. Now God has blessed him, and his family is in the church.</p>	<p><i>Thanksgiving Testimonies:</i> Several of our adults and young people told what they are thankful for. Then Pastor Joseph preached about our need to be thankful, reading texts from Isaiah 46:5-13, and Ezekiel 16:1-6.
