Elder Charles Hoskins preached from Mark 11:12-26. Jesus is the great I Am. He is with us when we are on the mountaintop and also when we are in a desert. Jesus cursed the fig tree because it wasn't bearing fruit. We are the salt of the earth and the light of this world. People hear what we say. It can affect others. Stand on God's Word. Have faith in God. Speak His Word. Faith is now. We must look past our problems and have faith in God. If we truly have faith in God, all we have to do when there's a mountain before us is pray. If we believe that the mountain will go away, it will. Have faith in God when you face your challenges. He will give you fruit in due season. Whenever you are sick, call for the elders of the church, and they will pray. You shall be forgiven and raised up (see James 5:15). "The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much" (James 5:16). The Canaanite woman fell down at Jesus' feet and worshipped Him. He told her that it wasn't proper to give the children's bread to dogs. She said even dogs eat crumbs from their master's table. He told her, "great is thy faith." God blessed her, even a as a Gentile. We must keep our faith in Him. He will give us fruit in due season.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "The Threefold Cord" using the fourth chapter of Ecclesiastes as his text. The Book of Ecclesiastes may seem on the surface like a very dark and depressing book, but it is actually just an honest assessment of our dark, sin-cursed world. The wise writer of the book considered all the oppression that goes on in the earth, and he lamented that the oppressed had no comforter. He considered all the work that people do in trying to "keep up" with their neighbors, and all the trouble that people cause themselves in trying to gain riches, and found it all to be vanity. He portrayed another extreme of a fool who does nothing to gain money and thus comes to homeless ruin. The secret to godly success is between the two extremes. One of the most poignant portions of the chapter considers the most priceless commodity ever: true companionship. We ought to strive to protect our marriages, our friendships, and our church. The value of these areas of relationship cannot be overstated. Loneliness is the saddest state. More than just Himself, God has provided people to us for companions. Don't let any wound, transgression, or disagreement separate you from your companions. A "threefold cord is not quickly broken." Be mature. Rise above. It's worth it.

Wednesday

Pastor Joseph taught a lesson about understanding prophecy, using chapters 7, 8, and 9 of the Book of Isaiah. There are several keys, called laws, that help in studying prophecies. Pastor Joseph explained two important keys: The Prophetic Law of Similar Things, and the Prophetic Law of Multiple Fulfillment. Isaiah 7:14, one of the most famous Christmas verses of all, is a verse that displays the reality of multiple fulfillment. Also, many verses about the Millennial Kingdom age have a dual fulfillment. The saints in the Church Age receive (in a somewhat

spiritual sense) what the Jews will get (in more physical ways) during the Millennial Kingdom. Jesus' birth fulfilled many prophecies, including Isaiah 9:6, one of the verses quoted most often as proof of the oneness of God and of the mighty God in Christ. Knowing its context (by studying preceding chapters and by knowing about the laws of prophecy) makes the verse even more powerful.
