Pastor Joseph preached "Rehoboam's Folly" using II Chronicles 10:8. Upon the death of Solomon, the third king of the twelve tribes of Israel, Solomon's son, Rehoboam, was the "heir apparent." However, a serious error on Rehoboam's part prevented him from ever becoming king of all twelve tribes. Instead, the united kingdom was split, and only two tribes followed him. His two southern tribes became known as Judah while the ten northern tribes kept the name of Israel. This terrible split was a tragic event in the period of Jewish monarchs. What was his error? He valued the counsel of his young peers more than the counsel of the silver-haired old men. Before Rehoboam was coronated, the people asked him what kind of king he was going to be. They pledged to serve him if he would be easier on them than his father had been He recessed and asked the older men for counsel. They told him to answer that he would be easier; they advised that if he answered correctly, the people would always serve him. He then also took counsel with the younger men. The younger men told him the opposite; to say he would be harder than his father was. They used words such as "whip with scorpions." Sadly, he answered according to the counsel of his young peers. Thus, Israel ceased to be a united kingdom. Rehoboam's folly was that he wouldn't listen to the counsel of the older men. Gentleness can do what violence cannot do. Young people, look to aged, godly people in your journey of life with God. Respect the silver-haired saints. Value the counsel of the elderly. They have great experience in their walk with God.

Pastor Joseph preached "Perpetual Motion" using II Chronicles 7:11-14. Engineers have tried to create a perfectlybalanced. friction-free machine that can continue in motion perpetually with no loss of energy and no additional power needed after it being started.
