There's going to be a change in our lives and</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "Repentance Before Remission" using Matt 5:21-24. Jesus taught that if you bring your offering to the altar, and there remember that your brother has ought against you, you should leave your offering at the altar, and go be reconciled with your brother, and then return to the altar. Without shedding of blood there is no remission (no forgiveness of sins), but the shedding of blood at the altar will do no good unless the worshipper first makes things right in his or her relationships. We must be reconciled or else we will not be saved. Church attendance and tithing will do us no good if we have problems with our brother that need taken care of. Each choice we make affects others. If you choose to sin, don't think you are hurting no one but yourself. That is false rationalization. Even if your sin does not directly hurt others, all sins by their nature hurt the one who commits the sin. Thus, as you hurt yourself, you are sinning against all who love you. At Pentecost, Peter stressed that repentance and water baptism are essential prerequisites for remission of sins. God can grant you the power to change. In order to have a relationship with Jesus such as Paul had, we need to be faithful—not only in prayer but also in studying the Word and fasting. We need to desire more than anything to have a walk with God so strong that when we pray, hell trembles, and when we speak the name of Jesus, demons must flee because they not only know who Paul is and who Jesus is, but they also know who you are, as you have that same relationship with Jesus that Paul had. 


