



<p>Pastor Joseph preached "Let the Living Water Flow" using Ezekiel 47:1-12 & John 7:37-38. Ezekiel's vision resulted in an ancient prophecy of living waters flowing from the temple. This will have literal fulfillment during the Millennial Kingdom, but it has spiritual fulfillment now: Our bodies are the temple of the Holy Ghost. Jesus said that out of our belly (or innermost being) shall flow rivers of living water. This is a promise from God's word for those who believe on Him. The living waters bring healing and life. We are the temple. We need to believe that God's promise is true. This does not apply just to preachers; it is for all who believe the promise of God. "And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover" (Mark 16:17-18). The promise is not just to the rich, or the young, or males, or the wise. It is to those who believe. Whether we teach a Bible study, dress modestly, or however we keep His commandments, we are letting living waters flow.</p>	<p>Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Why Are You Standing Still?" using Exodus 14:13-15. Jesus told His disciples to go preach the gospel to every creature. God doesn't want us to come into His church only to sit and do nothing. He wants us to pray, fast, witness, and teach Bible studies. We need to step out in faith and do the works of God. At first Moses told the children of Israel to stand still. However, God chastised Moses, saying they should go forward. When they listened, then the Red Sea parted and they were saved. Step out in faith and you can see miracles. We need to trust God. He is a Waymaker. Keep going forward with your work for God. When God tells you to go and talk to someone, don't stop and ponder "Should I go?" Just go. Don't sit and wait to witness to people; you'll fail them. When we give to others, God will bless and multiply just as He did for the little boy with the loaves and fishes. Go share what God has done for you. God has given us a command to go, so let us not stand still.</p>	<p>Elder David Harris Jr. preached "This is Only Temporary" using II Corinthians 4:7-18. Our trials and tests are only a light affliction when compared with eternity. These trials are only temporary. When we cry unto the Lord, He lifts us up. Our weeping may endure for a night, but joy will come in the morning. God has not forgotten us when we are going through trials. We have power through the Holy Ghost to succeed. Everything is not what it seems to be. "We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed" (II Corinthians 4:8-9). Jesus loves us, and that is all that really matters. Earthly things are only temporary. Focus on things eternal.</p>
