
Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "God Will Not Fail You" using Deuteronomy 31:6-8, Hebrews 12:12-24 & Joshua 3:9-16. Jesus has never failed. Be strong and be of good courage. If God is on our side we can't lose. If we have repented, been baptized in Jesus' name, and received the Holy Ghost then we have a covenant relationship with Jesus Christ. We have a promise that He won't fail us. Joshua told the children of Israel "the living God is among you," and "he will without fail drive out" the enemy. Once you have seen miracles, don't fear when another trial comes in your life. Greater is He that is in you than he that is in the world. Fear not; God will never forsake or fail you. Make every effort to live at peace with all men. Be peacemakers. Don't sow discord. Don't listen to others talking about someone. Walk diligently lest a root of bitterness spring up. Trust in the success of the church because God doesn't fail. The church is destined to succeed.

Pastor Joseph preached "Stand" from Ephesians 6:10-18. In four verses (11-14) "stand" is seen four times. In v. 11, we are to put on the whole armor of God, so that we "may be able to **stand** against the wiles of the devil." Two verses later we are again reminded to take the whole armor of God, so that we "may be able to with**stand in the evil day**, and having done all, to **stand**." The pieces of the armor are introduced with, "**Stand** therefore." We are living in the evil day. Evil is called good, and good is called evil. Christianity and Bible truth are viewed as problems that society has to deal with. The rights of Christians are being taken away so that special protection may be granted to the notion that homosexuality is not a sin. The world no longer just wants to sin. It now demands that we not declare their sin to be sin. In this evil day, we need to **stand**. We need God's help. We need His armor, and we need each other. Remember that the enemy is not people, primarily. "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood..." Together, let us **stand**.
