Last Sunday AM

Elder Lorren Godwin preached “A Tale of Two Gentlemen” using Matthew 19:16-22. The Lord did so much for us. He loves us. He sacrificed Himself for us on Mt. Calvary. All He asks of us is to follow Him. Is that too much? Jesus told the rich young ruler to sell all that he had and give to the poor and then follow Him. When the man heard this he went away sorrowful. We must be willing to give up all for Jesus—even to take time out of our busy schedule to help someone. Jesus asks “come and follow me.” We must be born again to have fellowship with God. He wants us to have a receiving-and-giving relationship with Him. Be consumed with serving the Lord. Desire to be like Him. Do things to please Him and get closer to Him. If we truly love the Lord then we will do our best to obey His instructions. The man who was possessed by a legion of devils, when he saw Jesus, ran to Him and fell down and worshipped Him. The world had given up on that man, but Jesus freed him, casting the devils into a herd of pigs. This man then wanted to follow Him. Jesus can change us if we will just give up **all** and follow Him.

Sunday PM

Elder David Harris Jr. preached a faith, message entitled “Healing Water” from John 7:37-39. Jesus said “He that believeth on me....out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.” Jesus is the living water. We who have the Holy Ghost have the living water inside of us. Such power! We can see all kinds of miracles. All we have to do is believe and speak the name of Jesus and it will happen. Jesus came to a man who for 38 years had laid by a pool to be healed when the waters were troubled. He said to him, “Wilt thou be made whole?” The man said that he had no man to help him to the pool. Jesus told him, “Take up thy bed and walk.” We need to change our attitude and stop making excuses. Let the living water inside of us change us. Jesus can make a way where there is no way. You must believe when you are prayed for. God knows we have problems and what we are going through. We have healing waters in us. We can lay hands on the sick and they shall recover. The Holy Ghost anointing will flow out of us.

Wednesday

Pastor Joseph taught a lesson on “Wisdom” from James 1:1-5. Of all the books of the New Testament, the most Jewish is the Epistle of James (even more so than Matthew’s Gospel.) It fits well with the Jewish wisdom literature in the Old Testament. James, the eldest of the half-brothers of Jesus, was well suited to write of asking God for wisdom. He served as the pastor of the Jerusalem Church. He moderated a potentially explosive council meeting described in Acts 15, and led the council in seeking and obtaining wisdom from the Lord in how to deal with one of the most challenging matters of their day. His solid advice is: If anyone lacks wisdom, simply ask God, who will freely give wisdom. Wisdom is doing what God says is the right thing. There are two issues: (1) to know (or learn) what is right, and (2) be willing to do what is right. Some don’t know what to do. Some who do know...simply don’t want to. A great deal of wisdom is revealed in the →

Bible. For things not covered there, ask God directly. If anyone lacks wisdom, ask God. He will give it freely. However, we all need to be careful that our carnal nature does not stop us from doing what is right, even if we already know what is right. Any believer who does not pray, fast, study the Bible, and stay faithful to church, will find his carnal nature rising up. Any of us can backslide. Keep your “inner self” strong through prayer, fasting, Bible study and church attendance.






