Elder David Harris Jr. preached "Don't Doubt But Shout!" from II Corinthians 10:3-5. Don't doubt. God knows all about your problems before they happen. He'll take care of you. Doubt causes more problems. Let your mind dwell on what God can do. Don't dwell on your problems and doubts. Ask God and He will direct you. He will give you answers. Think of the goodness of Jesus and all He has done for you. "Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you" (I Peter 5:7). "Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think" (Ephesians 3:20). "If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it" (John 14:14). No problem is too big for God. The Holy Ghost is real! We can testify about people who were touched by God and their lives were changed for the better. Doubt will still come back tomorrow. Act upon your faith, even if you have doubts. If you're thinking you have only a slim chance of being saved, then act on that chance. We have a promise that a doubtful step toward God is better than the most certain step in the world. Don't doubt God's promises.


Pastor Joseph preached "A Little Bit Crazy!" The text, II Kings 6:24-7:2, tells of a time of terrible desperation. The Syrian army had besieged Samaria, causing a great famine. People inside the city walls were starving, some even becoming cannibals. Today we are in a time of *spiritual* famine. In desperate times, one's true nature is revealed. The king of Samaria decided to blame God and kill God's prophet. When desperate, don't turn against God, the church, or the preacher! God warned the prophet about the king and also revealed great news that stopped the king from killing him. The preacher prophesied that an abundance of food was coming the very next day. The king's counselor said it was crazy; impossible. His doubt was deadly to him. Yet with God, nothing is impossible. The prophet told him that he would see the food but not taste it. Four lepers were in the gates of the city. In desperation they decided to do something crazy; to go to the enemy camp. God liked their kind of crazy. Today there are people outside the church just like those lepers. They don't know the gospel can save them. Yet they are so desperate, they're ready to do something a bit crazy repent, be baptized, and be filled with the Holy Ghost! If they're crazy enough to obey the gospel, let's be crazy enough to go tell it! God caused the enemy soldiers to flee! The lepers brought word to the city. The people stampeded for the food and the king's counselor was trampled in the gate. We, just like those lepers, don't need to fear that we're inadequate, unprepared, not up to the task, or that we might fail. Just be a little bit crazy, desperate, and willing to do something for God! Desperate times call for desperate measures! We need to get a little crazy in worship, praise, prayer, fasting, witnessing, preaching, healing, and fellowship!

Elder David Harris Jr preached "A Cry From Yonder" using Genesis 22:4-5. Abraham knew the presence of the Almighty God. He knew what God had promised. He told the men **we** (he and Isaac) will go worship and come back. Don't ever stop praying. God will answer. Sometimes we get in a hurry through things and we miss the blessings of God. We need to get to the place where it's just us and God. Seek God.

We need to listen to the voice of God. Don't pray only when you are going through bad times, but also when everything is going good for you. We need to pull ourselves yonder so we can see Jesus. We serve a great, big God. He will perform miracles for us. All we have to do is pray and believe.
