Pastor Joseph taught a lesson about duty, entitled "The Family of the Unsandaled" from Deuteronomy 25:1-10. Under Mosaic law, if brothers dwelt together and one of them died without a son, the surviving brother was to marry the dead brother's wife and fulfill the duty of a brother-in-law to her. If he did not marry her even after the elders of the town talked to him, she was go to him in the presence of the elders, take off one of his sandals, and spit in his face. This world is contrary to God and the things of God. They don't want to be told how they should live and what to do. The whole duty of man is to fear God and keep His commandments. Men don't want to follow God's plan and fulfill their duty today. We are to have our "feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace" (Ephesians 6:15). It is our duty to reach the lost. We should do everything that we possibly can to tell the gospel to others. "How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace; that bringeth good tidings of good that publisheth salvation; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigneth!" (Isaiah 52:7). Do your duty. God has given salvation to us, so we must tell others.

Pastor Joseph preached "Faith" from I Corinthians 2:1-5, 14-16 & 3:1-23. Whenever you have faith, speak the name of Jesus with boldness and confidence. If we stay sweet in the spirit among ourselves, God will perform awesome miracles for us. Let us not be carnal. Don't let jealousy and quarreling divide us. Firm preaching is needed. The world needs a church that will speak the truth in love, even though carnal people won't ever understand the truths of God because these truths are spiritually discerned. A carnal person can't understand spiritual things. The Lord has called each one of us to be a witness, or messenger. A messenger has to give account for the message he is to deliver. We must all be faithful stewards. We must speak the truth in love and not water it down. Some people just won't receive this truth, but we won't be held accountable for their denial. The world thinks this gospel is foolishness, but it is the power of God unto salvation.


Wednesday


